



Fraud Alert



At PJG, we are committed to protecting our clients, employees, and partners from fraudulent activity. This Fraud Alert Statement is intended to inform you of potential fraud schemes and help you stay vigilant when interacting with our company or its representatives.

Common Fraud Schemes

1. Fake Invoices and Billing Scams

Fraudsters may attempt to send fake invoices or solicit payments under the guise of PJG. These fraudulent invoices may appear to be for services that were never provided or are significantly inflated.

2. Impersonation of PJG Representatives

Scammers may pretend to be employees or contractors of PJG, either over the phone, via email, or in person. They may try to gain access to personal information or financial details, or pressure clients into making unauthorized payments.

3. Unsolicited Offers for Services

Be cautious of unsolicited calls, emails, or messages offering services, particularly those that ask for immediate payments or request sensitive personal information. PJG will never ask for payment before providing services, nor will we contact you out of the blue.

How to Protect Yourself

- **Verify the Source:** Always confirm that the communication (invoice, email, phone call, etc.) is legitimate. If you have any doubts, contact PJG directly using contact details from our official website or documents.
- **Be Cautious of Payment Requests:** Never make payments or share financial information unless you are certain the request is legitimate. PJG typically provides clients with detailed contracts and invoices before any payments are due.
- **Look for Red Flags:** Watch for urgent or high-pressure tactics, demands for payment in unusual forms (e.g., gift cards, wire transfers), or requests for personal information that seem unnecessary.



What to Do If You Suspect Fraud

If you suspect that you have been contacted by a fraudster claiming to represent PJG, or if you believe you have been a victim of fraud:

1. **Do Not Engage:** Do not respond to the fraudulent communication or provide any personal or financial information.
2. **Contact Us:** Notify us immediately at [Insert Phone Number] or [Insert Email Address]. We will verify the authenticity of any communication and take appropriate action.
3. **Report the Incident:** In cases of fraud or suspicious activity, consider reporting the incident to local law enforcement or your bank to prevent further loss or identity theft.

- We will never ask for immediate payments or ask you to send money via unconventional methods (e.g., wire transfers or gift cards).
- Our team will always provide official invoices, contracts, and receipts for all services provided.
- We conduct regular training to ensure our employees are aware of and prevent fraudulent activity.
